Content Overview:

This professional development session provides educators with the tools and strategies to craft high-quality, measurable IEP goals that drive student growth and educational benefit. Participants explore how to align goals with state standards, develop meaningful baselines, and write goals that address academic, behavioral, social-emotional, and functional needs.

Key topics include:

- Connecting goals to grade-level standards and California Preschool/TK Learning Foundations
- Writing firm goals with flexible means to encourage creativity and inclusion
- Developing baselines using multiple data sources and avoiding common pitfalls
- Writing linguistically appropriate goals for English learners with disabilities, in collaboration with Imperial County SELPA and Project MuSE resources
- Addressing non-academic areas, including executive functioning, behavior, and attendance
- Monitoring and reporting progress effectively to ensure accountability and communication with families
