Cohen Miles-Rath

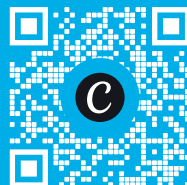
Cohen shares what it means to face a crisis, rebuild trust with loved ones, learn to live with mental illness, and transform lived experience into change.
