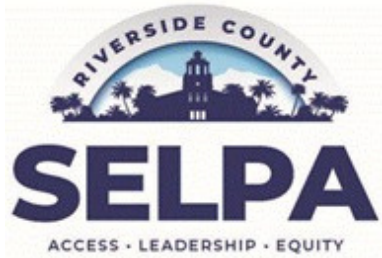

- Review psychiatric holds and re-entry practices to support students safely transitioning back into their environment.
