Riverside County SELPA "Trainer of Trainer" Workshop

Meetings will be held In-Person and Virtual, 12:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Riverside County SELPA will be hosting TOT meetings with built in trainings for LEA staff responsible for SEIS trainings within their districts. All meetings will be held virtually. Each LEA will need to have (at minimum) 1–2 TOT trainers attending the meetings, depending on the size of the district. Riverside County SELPA will provide presentations and support documents as appropriate for participants to use for trainings in district. TOT members receive e-mail notifications regarding changes to the SEIS system, new features in SEIS, and problems discovered in SEIS with workarounds if any are available. If problems with data entry or IEP document completion are found in SEIS, TOT members will receive updates with training materials to help correct wrong practices. We are continuing to come to grips with the changes resulting from reporting Special Education data in CALPADS. This means the need for instruction on changes in practices and procedures is high. The TOT group will be at the forefront of this instruction.
