7. SELPA Business

7.1 Legislative and Fiscal Updates

a. Bill Updates

February 17 is the last day for bills to be introduced. There are 2,500 proposed bills across the board.

- SB 354 (Ochoa-Bogh) sponsored by state SELPA. The bill is around inclusion to expand the administrative credential to engage in specific training around UDL. The bill includes some language specific to DHH.
- AB 1517-(Gallagher) seeks to amend 4 components of the Ed code. Expanding LCAP. Bump up the implementation date of the local plan section C or the annual assurances plan. RC SELPA holds a seat as co chair of that committee.
- SB 323-(Portintino) requires students with exceptional needs to be included in IEP.
- AB 438- would lower the age to transition planning to age 14.
- AB 447-require public post secondary to create pilot college programs. Creating a workgroup.
- SB 483 -(Cortese) eliminates prone restraint.
- SB 691- Reduced the screening grade for dyslexia screening.
 From Kindergarten to the 2nd grade to screen within the first 90 days of school.

7.2 Compliance and Improvement Monitoring

a. Small Schools Monitoring

Will not be included in compliance monitoring next year. Will receive a list of small schools/charter of our schools that will be included in compliance monitoring. Desert Center will not receive an annual performance review.

b. IEP Implementation Monitoring

Passwords have not been released yet. Perris Union HS district refused to meet the timeline due to a delayed notice.

c. Compliance and Implementation Monitoring and

Differentiated Assistance

Kellie will facilitate a presentation during SEA on the CIM process and DA overlap. The Annual determination letters are no longer called "the mega letter". It is expected that roughly 500 districts will be identified for targeted 1 or 2. Targeted 3 and Intensive levels will be assigned a tech assistance provider. No significant changes to the monitoring process. Plans are due November 1st.
