6.4. Compliance and Improvement Monitoring

a. Annual Determination Notification Letters

A week ago, districts should have received annual determination letters. Seven districts are in intensive monitoring, one in Significant Disproportionality and one is new to intensive monitoring. The other five districts were part of intensive monitoring last year. New opportunities will allow districts to write a comprehensive plan and adjust as they see fit. The monitoring cycle is a 3-year cycle. All LEAs have a SELPA coordinator attached to them.

RCOE-compliance monitoring can be done hand in hand with Differentiated Assistance. RC SELPA works with the Riverside COE monthly.

b. IEP Implementation Monitoring

IEP monitoring-CDEs newest version of monitoring IEP services. Currently in the collection window. A list will be received identifying students of what percentage of services were implemented. The list will represent about 10% of your students. Larger LEAs will have a list of about 350 students.

6.5. Approve amendments to the Riverside County SELPA Allocation Plan

6.6. Riverside County SELPA and Spectrum Non Public School

- a. Master Contract
- b. Facilities Location and Cost
- c. Transportation

Will take action on the master contract with Spectrum at the next Special Governance Council meeting. RC SELPA was asked to explore an opportunity to open a NPS program. Spectrum proposed a cost to buy 48 seats for the RC SELPA program. The total cost is \$1,400,000- to include 4 SAI classrooms with a daily rate of about \$196. Hemet USD has identified a facility that has 4 classrooms, an administrative area, and a blacktop. Hemet USD will paint and add new carpet. Still working with Hemet USD to identify a facility cost. RC SELPA would then make an MOU with Hemet USD. Will split costs among LEAs that want to use the NPS; similar system as RCOE uses for services. Spectrum would be open to duplicating at other locations if they find facilities in RC SELPA. Anticipate an August 1 opening. Hemet USD will offer transportation for individual needs. Hemet USD would carry individual MOUs with the LEA for an additional cost. If the student needs a 1:1 it would be a \$190 day fee. Interest list will be sent out once the master contract is ready.

6.7. Process for Approval of Vendor and Service Provider Contracts

Will be brought forward at the May GC meeting. A large software contract was flagged as a VVUSD board agenda item. This brought up the opportunity to talk with the Val Verde business department on the process of contracts, including NPS and RTCs. Beginning next school year there will be a consent item of contracts to allow checks and balances. Some contracts may have to be ratified due to not having monthly meetings.
